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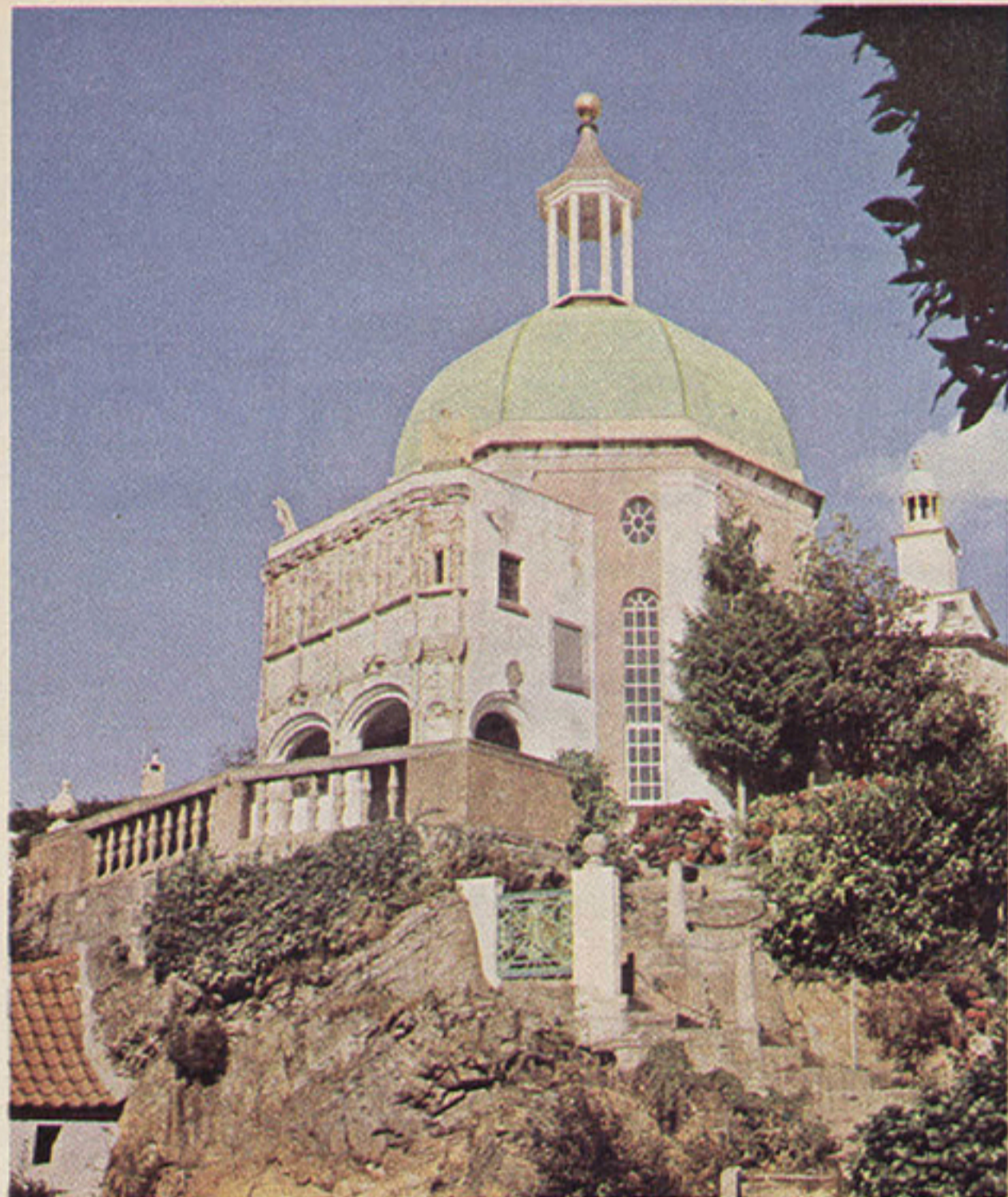

Thirty-five years ago the dream village of architect Clough Williams-Ellis blossomed and grew on the coastline of Caernarvonshire. He christened it Portmeirion and its splendid Italian-inspired buildings are a feast for the tourists' cameras.
